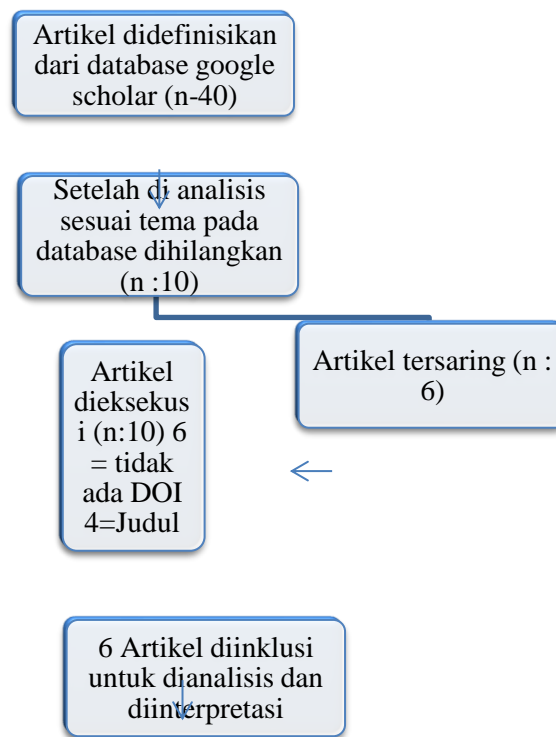


Figure 1. Flowchart related to Systematic Literature Review (SLR) steps
