SYSTEMATIC LITERATURE REVIEW(SLR):

THE IMPACT OF SOCIAL MEDIA AND TECHNOLOGY ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF CHARACTER EDUCATION FOR CHILDREN AND ADOLESCENTS

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ABSTRACT

Children's character development is increasingly influenced by technological developments, especially in the current digital era, social media and the influence of social media and technology on the development of children's moral values, attitudes and behavior. However, apart from the advantages, social media also brings new challenges, such as risks for children's development, such as dependence on negative content and lack of social interaction. The SLR (Systematic Literature Review) method is used in the research method. Data collection was obtained by collecting similar research articles. The articles obtained and used in this research were 7 national journal articles taken from the Google Scholar database via the publication application. Based on research, character education works actively to direct children towards positive use of social media and technology, develop strong self-awareness, and teach digital responsibility.

INTRODUCTION

Social media is a social communication tool. Using mobile and web-based technologies, social media creates highly interactive platforms for people to communicate, share, collaborate and modify the content they create. At the time this article was written, the media social creates relationships, news, complaints. In February 2020, internet users in Indonesia experienced significant rapid growth from year to year. Data released by the Ministry of Communication and Information (Kemenkominfo) shows that in 2013, the number of internet users in Indonesia had reached 63 million. What's interesting about this data is that 95 percent of internet use is for social media. Based on the latest data in January 2019, the number of social networking users in Indonesia has increased to 150 million or the equivalent of 56% of Indonesia's population.







Sample data shows that on average almost 80% of urban and rural residents use the Internet, namely on social networks, and only another 20% use it for studying or sending emails. And Internet Trends data (2019) organized by Hootsuite shows that the group of school social network users aged 13 -17 years constitutes 15% of Indonesia's total population.

Many students no longer consider the topics taught by teachers essential, they are instead more interested in entertainment so that their academic performance decreases. Social media has several well-known functions, including: finding news, information and knowledge more quickly according to the definition of social media, getting entertainment, makes it easier for social media users to interact online. , such as sharing space or updating space, providing news and information, interacting and sharing invitations, facilitating communication, can trigger broad participation from the community, become a platform for sharing information at the global level, promote products or introduce local brands globally, and create opportunities new jobs such as social media marketing services and social media management, advertising and of course our talent or skill identification. own (LarasatI 2021).

The progress of technological development is currently very rapid with various modern technological discoveries which aim to facilitate human mobility and access every day (Hidayat and Maesyaroh, 2020) which is a clear example of how information technology, which has existed for centuries and continues to develop until now (Siregar and Marpaung, 2020), has an impact on everyday life. In the 21st century, apart from striking technological developments, the importance of children's character development is also increasingly being paid attention to. The influence of technology on children's personalities and characters, especially at the elementary school level, is in the spotlight. Character education is considered a key aspect in forming a quality generation, facilitating the application of positive values in everyday life (Sholekhah, 2019). What should be done? Researchers often look at In the era of modern technology, the surrounding environment, the internet, and social media have a huge impact on children. Many children are affected by toxic content, harsh words, inappropriate jokes and inappropriate clothing styles. These things can harm a child's development. Research at Makasari Elementary School shows that bad behavior such as bullying and lack of respect for teachers is increasing among students. It is important to reduce these negative impacts through better education.

According to Muslich (2011), education is a process in which culture is understood and internalized by individuals and society so as to shape human and societal civilization. Therefore, school education is an important means of developing student character. Character education is needed as a solution to overcome problems related to children's attitudes and behavior (Bani et al., 2023). This involves shaping a child's personality through various influences, including guidance from parents, teachers, media, technology, and other aspects of life (Agnia et al., 2021). This research aims to understand the impact of the use of social media and the surrounding environment on students' character development. Technology has on children's character development and how it affects their overall character education.

RESEARCH METHODS

This research is a literature analysis using the Systematic Review (SR) method, also known as Systematic Literature Review (SLR). This method systematically evaluates, integrates, and compares findings from various research questions or topics you want to explore. The systematic literature review (SLR) research method is a systematic and structured approach to collecting, evaluating, and synthesizing relevant research in a particular field or topic. SLR includes clear steps for searching, selecting, evaluating, and synthesizing evidence from various literature sources used to gain a holistic and neutral understanding of the subject under investigation. A systematic review is an approach to understanding a problem by identifying, evaluating, and selecting clear, specific questions based on certain criteria. This is a continuation of previous qualitative research that focused on research questions. The method used in this research is a Systematic Literature Review (SLR), a systematic, clear, and replicable approach to identifying, evaluating, and combining research results and ideas. It is carried out by researchers and specialists in the field with the aim of collecting, reviewing and evaluating all relevant research. This research involved several stages, including.







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First, how social media can play a positive role in forming children's character. Second, the sample group in this research are magazines that focus on developing children's character through the influence of social media. The literature search process begins by utilizing available data sources, such as Google Scholar, obtained through publication or destruction. The keywords used are the impact of social media and technology on the development of children's character education in 2024.\nThird, after receiving various articles. Researchers found 50 articles discussing the impact of social media and technology on children's character formation through searches in the Google Scholar database. After that, 20 articles that were most relevant to the article title were selected for further research and selection. The researcher then decided to study the 20 articles that were researched and selected in detail and in depth with 7 articles that were appropriate to the topic of discussion. Then 30 other articles did not contain discussion or research. Obtained 7 articles that are mostly in accordance with the research topic. The analysis and closing section presents a flow diagram of the selection, evaluation and inclusion process at the systematic review stage (n: number of articles).

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Results

The basic concept of education is a transformative process, where a person develops into himself, according to his potential, character, talent and morality. The aim of education is not only to shape the character and skills of students and teachers (Arifin, 2020), but also to teach values such as respect for others, hard work, and so on. This statement is in line with what Jessup said at the beginning of his work (Musayyidi and Rudi, 2020).





Apart from that, character education aims to shape students into moral and ethical citizens, who will contribute to the realization of a just, safe and prosperous national life. The aim is to speed up learning so that the younger generation is ready to enter the stage of maturity, which is the path to civilization. This education is also considered an effort to transmit cultural values and social norms (Ahmad and Ahmad, Ali Miftakhu Rosyad 2019). This means giving labels and focuses attention on ways of assessing goodness manifested in the form of actions or behavior. It can be said that moral rules that are respected by individuals who have high integrity are called noble behavioral guidelines. Character education, as explained by Lickona (2021), is a deliberate effort to help people understand and appreciate basic moral principles, so that they can internalize these values and act in accordance with moral awareness. In simple terms, character education can be understood as all efforts made by teachers to shape students' character and morality, with the aim of creating a just, safe and prosperous society, in accordance with the desired vision of national life (Dini, 2018).

Education, as mandated in the National Education System Law Number 20 of 2003, aims to develop individual potential and form a civilized national identity and culture, in order to improve the quality of people's lives. This effort includes developing students' talents as well as forming characters who are religious, ethical, healthy, competent, creative, independent, and become democratic and responsible citizens. In the era of globalization, technology has an important role in education, not only as a learning tool, but also as a means of communication between teachers and students. However, the use of technology can also have negative impacts such as cyberbullying, brawls, violence and sexual harassment against children, which shows the weakness of the nation's character. Therefore, it is necessary to develop good national character from an early age so that society can instill positive values and behavior in future generations. This determines the size of the crime in the cases mentioned above.

The use of technology in character education for elementary school students has quite a positive impact, but it also has several negative impacts that need to be overcome and watched out for. One common problem is the potential for technology addiction. According to Pratiwi (2019), children who use technology excessively tend to become too attached to screens and spend less time interacting socially or doing physical activities. This can disrupt their character development, leading to low independence, lack of empathy, and lack of social skills. Apart from that, the use of technology can also reduce direct social interaction. Pratiwi (2019) states that children who use technology too often may become isolated and lose opportunities to interact and communicate directly with peers, teachers and family. Direct social interaction is an important part of forming a child's character, including the ability to understand other people's feelings, have empathy, and communicate effectively

Character education must start from an early age because early childhood is a crucial foundation for individual growth and development in the future. Changing a person's character is not easy because it requires time, habituation of attitudes and behavior, and a continuous process. However, by implementing the right procedures and starting early, it is still possible to instill good character values in a person (Jayawardana in Aini, Faturohman, Darmawan 2023).

* The impact of social media and technology on children and teenagers

The stimulation that occurs Reformulating or re-arranging sentences in the early stages of a child's development has a significant impact on their development. Children who receive stimulation appropriate to their age grow and develop into children who are physically and mentally ready to take part in the next level of education. At the same time, children who do not receive stimulation or good education at an early age will grow up to be children who are immature physically and spiritually. The stimulus or stimulation that children receive from the environment is very important Influence Transformations that occur in early childhood can be influenced by equipment that stimulates various aspects of development, such as moral and religious values, language, cognitive, social-emotional and physical motor skills. This can support optimal overall development of children according to their age if they receive sufficient stimulation. At the same time, children who receive negative stimulation or



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stimuli will not develop well in the future.

The negative impact of technology in the digital era has the potential to damage the development of children's character and attitudes, which are vulnerable to being affected at an early age and can continue into adulthood if not treated. Researchers' observations show that children are often influenced by toxic content, harsh language, inappropriate humor and inappropriate clothing patterns that are widespread on the internet and social media. Behaviors such as bullying and indifference towards teachers are also observed directly in schools, highlighting the need for urgent educational measures to minimize these negative impacts...

Some of the negative impacts on the nature of students affected by technological developments are:

- 1) The influence of technology on the way students communicate is manifested in less respectful interactions with some teachers and peers. There is a lack of politeness and respect, for example in impolite student-teacher interactions, use of inappropriate words, and detrimental behavior towards colleagues.
- 2) Technology also influences students' attitudes and behavior, where teachers often have difficulty giving advice because of their loud way of speaking, impolite behavior, and lack of appearance that shows respect.
- 3) The impact of technology can be seen in student attitudes in classroom learning, where observations show little student involvement in the learning process. Some students were more interested in playing games or talking about games than focusing on learning, especially those sitting in the back row.

Negative influence of social networks

- a. Teenagers may become fixated on social media use without paying attention to the time of day, often spending hours on social networking sites.
- b. Teenagers may avoid social interactions in the real world and their language skills may suffer from engaging in too much online interaction.
- c. Social media can increase selfish attitudes in teenagers, making them less sensitive to their surroundings because too much time is spent on the internet, which can reduce empathy in real life.
- d. Dependence on social media, especially for playing games, can reduce teenagers' learning motivation because of the time spent playing games on social media, such as Facebook.
- e. The use of social media can affect teenagers' manners, with the increasing use of inappropriate language on these platforms, which can be misunderstood by teenagers as the norm in young people's relationships.
- f. Social networking sites often do not enforce grammar and spelling rules for teens, making it difficult for them to differentiate between online and real-life interactions.

The positive influence of social networks

- a. Teenagers are motivated to improve themselves and learn through online interactions with their friends, providing each other with encouragement and feedback.
- b. Blogs and websites make it easier for teenagers to quickly access information from the internet, while social networks are also a source of information on a variety of topics, including education and culture.





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- c. Social networks help shape teenagers' personalities by encouraging them to show kindness, wisdom, and empathy, such as wishing them a happy birthday or making positive comments.
- d. Teenagers can easily share their life experiences with others through blogs, allowing them to share their stories and thoughts.
- e. Social media is becoming a platform for advertising for the younger generation involved in online business, with advertising services provided by platforms such as Blogger, Facebook and Twitter. This allows them to reach a wider audience through advertisements placed on these sites.

Social media has various influences on the formation of children's character

starting from the applications used, the content presented, to the negative effects that may arise. Social media applications have an important role in shaping children's character, depending on the type of application chosen. If children use applications that support learning and socialization, children's character tends to develop positively. However, if a child chooses an application that makes him lazy about studying, the child's character can be negatively affected. Substance theory emphasizes that the use of social media and character formation depend on the substance of the application, the content presented, and the resulting effects. This indicates that the character of a social media user is influenced by how the application is used, content selection, and the impact received. This concept is in accordance with the theory of action proposed by Norman (2017).

Each individual acts rationally based on how they understand situations, interactions, social experiences, and various sources of reference. This implies that a person's behavior in using social media is influenced by these factors. Social media fundamentally influences the formation of children's character, depending on the type of platform used, whether it has a positive or negative impact. Therefore, it is important to introduce, control and supervise children's use of social media so that it can be implemented correctly

The content presented on social media is related to the formation of children's character. This content must be tailored to the child's needs, and parents need to pay attention to their child's activities on their devices to prevent them from accessing negative content that could have a negative impact on their character. The role of parents is to be good friends for children, so that children feel comfortable sharing their activities. Every individual needs information and knowledge to understand various aspects of life, and many children seek this information through social media. However, this information can carry messages that need to be considered - messages that are needed as a reference for children, which are closely related to a person's character development. Dominant messages play an important role in the development of dominant character in a person. If the data contains a negative message source, then negative characters are easily formed and vice versa.

Usually, situations like this are caused by the use of cellphones and various games and applications on them which often pay little attention to positive character values. In this context, the teacher's role is very important in shaping student character. Teachers not only act as academic educators, but also as guides in terms of character, morals and culture for their students (Bani et al., 2023). Therefore, schools have made various efforts to reduce these negative impacts, although they have not been completely successful. One of the strategies used is implementing character education for students through routine self-development programs, such as educational activities every Friday, where teachers provide an understanding of good and bad behavior and give advice to students spontaneously at the beginning and end of learning. Apart from that, character education is also integrated into other subjects.

This shows that it is important for every educator to pay attention to moral principles and character in students. However, the role of parents is also very influential on the child's character (Celin, 2022).





The formation of children's character can be done through two approaches, namely through internal school and external school efforts. The school's internal approach includes four main aspects, namely classroom learning methods, daily school culture, instilled habits, and extracurricular and co-curricular activities. Meanwhile, the external approach involves the role of family and community. If these two approaches are implemented well, the child's character will be formed and become strong (Safitri, 2019).
