# THE INFLUENCE OF PARENTS AND TEACHERS IN BUILDING CHILDREN'S CHARACTER

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#### ABSTRACT

This study discusses the role of parents and teachers in shaping children's character. The SLR (Systematic Literature Review) method is used as a research method. Data collection is obtained by collecting articles related to similar research. The articles obtained and used in this study are 7 national journal articles taken from the Google Scholar database through the Publish or Perish application. The results showed that the role of parents and teachers is very important to influence the development and character of children, because as adults / parents must be good role models, because basically a child has characteristics that imitate what he sees and listens to. to. Therefore, as an adult/parent, he should set a good example that can also be used as an example in the development of children's character.

#### **INTRODUCTION**

Not only teaching moral values to students, but also developing the entire moral and ethical situation. The main goal is to guide the behavior of learners to conform to moral standards recognized by society. The purpose of character education is to improve human development to have integrity, compassion, responsibility, and critical thinking skills to face various world situations systematically and comprehensively. In the family environment should be used as a basic foundation in the formation of children's character in the future.

The family plays a very vital role as an environment in which children grow and develop from childhood to adulthood. Through education provided in the family, especially by parents, children's character is formedThe role of parents is very important as friends or partners of teachers in the education of their children. The involvement of parents in the school environment is very helpful for teachers in guiding and shaping the character of their students.

To create an example, the education provided at school and at home must be balanced and appropriate. This is because children can observe and apply the learning they get at school in their home life, and vice versa. The importance of balancing formal education at school and informal education at home to build children's personality. This compatibility supports the child's overall development through effective cooperation between parents and teachers. Therefore, cooperation between the education center and the family becomes important to create an effective and efficient learning environment that helps students develop their personality and life. This research will examine the different ways parents and teachers work together to shape a child's character, including an assessment of the cooperative relationship between them and the role of parents in helping their child develop into good character. This research aims to improve our understanding of the ways parents and teachers work together to improve children's learning at school and at home. "Discipline can be formed through good cooperation between teachers and parents, the cooperation can be: forming associations between parents and teachers for the formation of disciplinary character; conduct socialization of disciplinary character education; create programs for parents on discipline; and make agreements on discipline with parents to combat the impact of media on students." (Goddess, 2022).

One of the best ways to improve the quality of human life in various aspects of life is education. Education gives people the ability to change the way they think, behave, and act when facing and solving problems. Throughout human history, education has been a means used by diverse groups of individuals to improve themselves. This confirms the importance of education because of its crucial role in improving the quality of human life, especially in the modern era which is dominated by digital technology.





Everyone, including parents, must face the challenges of the digital age to shape their child's character. At home, parents influence the child's attitude. Parents carry out aspects of education to prepare children for social development. In other words, it includes the way parents teach their children in any way and the programs started or created to help them learn. Fundamental behavior Therefore, children will learn better if the role of parents is greater in educating them. "The various roles of parents are to provide a comfortable atmosphere for children's learning; accompany children to study at home; be a good example for the child; guiding and advising children; and communicate with the teacher." The process and strategy to prevent children from dropping out of school has been carried out systematically in Indonesia. However, when it comes to the strategy for children returning to school still have difficulties, as well as several obstacles and dilemmas to requites the right strategy. The purpose of this study is to examined the strategies of eradicating out-of-school children and the best practices of alternative schools to provide inclusive and free education Qualitative methods were chosen in the research process, primary data collection was carried out through in-depth interviews and focus group discussions (FGD) with 28 informants, includes policy makers, principals, teachers and students. The data was analyzed using thematic analysis (Rosmilawati, 2024).

This transformative learning lead students to have critical awareness in seeing, understanding, or make sense of life experiences or realities what is seen or felt. Transformative learning or transformative learning developed during this time focusing on efforts to resolve internal conflicts within oneself individual to achieve harmony, because the self is a central and integral part of totality of personality (Mustaqin, 2023).

## **RESEARCH METHODOLOGY**

Research is part of a literature review or other names Systematic Review (SR) or Systematic Literature Review (SLR). This method is a systematic way of collecting, critically evaluating, synthesizing and summarizing various research findings related to a research question or research topic. The research process begins with a search for literature related to the research topic, followed by the research process.

A systematic review is a method used to investigate a particular problem in a structured way. This method involves the process of identifying, evaluating, and selecting specific problems, as well as formulating clear questions that will be answered carefully based on predetermined criteria. The approach involves a methodological process used to build on previous research that is considered to be of high quality and relevant to the research question at hand. By using this approach, researchers can collect, evaluate, and integrate relevant previous research results to answer existing research questions. This approach helps in gaining a deeper understanding of the research topic and provides a solid foundation for the further development of knowledge in the field. Following this method allows researchers to identify, review and select previous studies that meet certain criteria, and incorporate these results into their own research. This approach allows researchers to build a solid and comprehensive information base when developing research questions, planning research designs, and conducting data analysis.

The Systematic Literature Review (SLR) method, a systematic, clear, and repeatable approach, is used in this study to identify, evaluate, and synthesize research and ideas conducted by academics and researchers. The goal is to find, examine, and evaluate all research related to the chosen topic. In this study, a series of procedures were used to collect and analyze data from relevant documents, such as:





The first question is: How do parents and teachers influence the child's character?

Second, the study's dataset focuses on how parents and teachers influence children's character development. The search for textbooks starts from data on Google Schoolar obtained through the Publish or Perish application. The Influence of Parents and Teachers on Children's Character Building was used as a keyword, limiting articles from 2020 to 2024.

Third, after getting a few articles. From a search of the Google Scholar database, researchers found 90 articles about the influence of parents and teachers on children's character development. Then, they selected 20 relevant articles from several articles related to Early Childhood Learning Community materials, and these 20 articles were added and filtered to produce 7 articles according to the language. Furthermore, out of a total of 70 articles reviewed, only seven articles met the criteria and were relevant to the main research topic. These articles are then included in the discussion and conclusion section to support the analysis and findings in the study. This shows that the selection of articles is done carefully to ensure that only the most relevant and high-quality research is used in the preparation of research discussions and conclusions.
