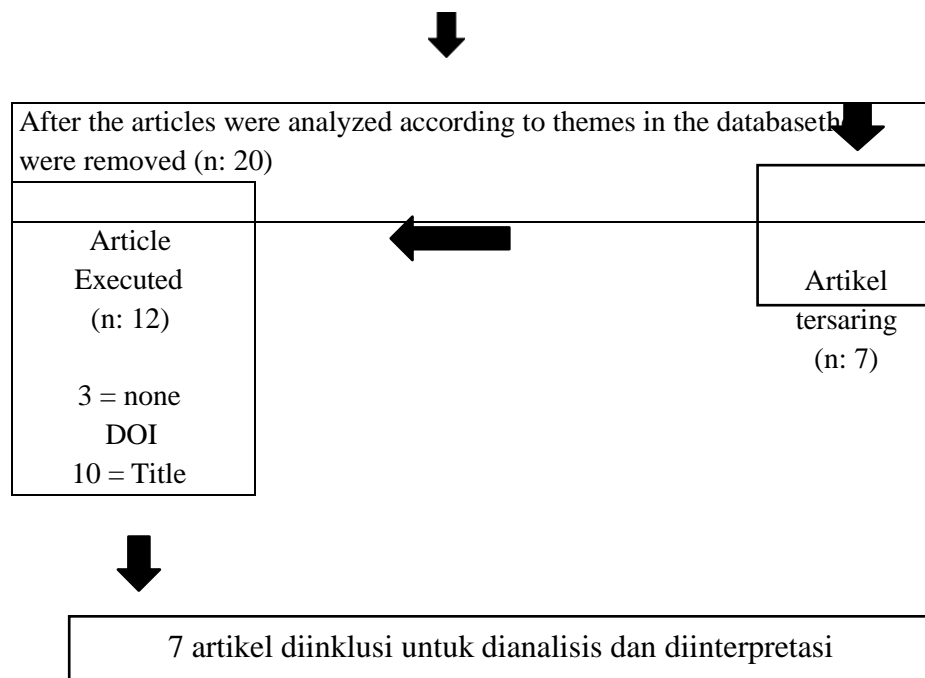


Figure 1. Flow diagram related to the Systematic Literature Review Steps
